CHAT Publication Award Call for Nominations

Overview

CANet is pleased to announce a call for nominations for the CHAT Publication Award. This award recognizes outstanding publications authored by a CHAT Trainee through nomination from CANet Network Investigators.

There will be one award for each of the following categories: basic research paper, and clinical research paper. Award recipients will be announced during the CANet Annual Scientific Conference at the Banquet Dinner to be held in Ottawa, Ontario on September 13, 2018. Award recipients will receive a letter of recognition and certificate signed by the CHAT Executive Committee Chairs, Chair of the TEC and the Scientific Director. A cash prize will also be awarded.

Eligibility

- The nominator must be a CANet Network Investigator
- The nominee must hold membership in CHAT
- The nominee should be the primary/first author on the submitted publication
- The publication should have been published/accepted within 24 months of the application deadline

Nomination Process and Submission

The nomination package includes:

- Letter of support from the nominator. This must detail the trainee's role in the research project and publication preparation (maximum 500 words)
- Letter from the nominee detailing their role in the research project and what they learned as a result of their experience (maximum 500 words)
- Copy of published/accepted manuscript

The nomination package should be compiled into a single PDF document and sent to research@canet-nce.ca by **4pm EST on August 27, 2018**.

Evaluation Criteria

The CHAT Executive Committee will select the winner based on the following characteristics:

- Evidence that the trainee was the primary contributor
- Evaluation of skills acquired during the project
- Impact and/or scientific merit of publication
